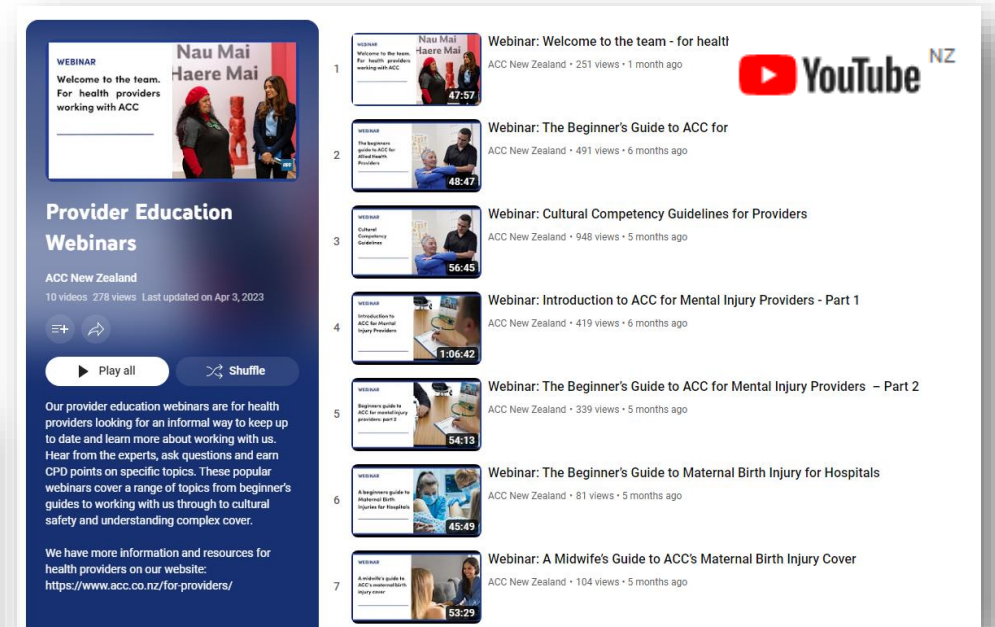
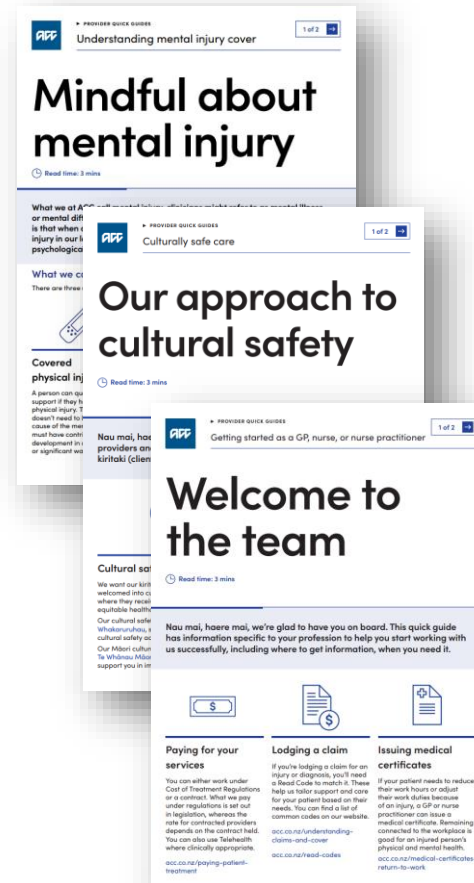
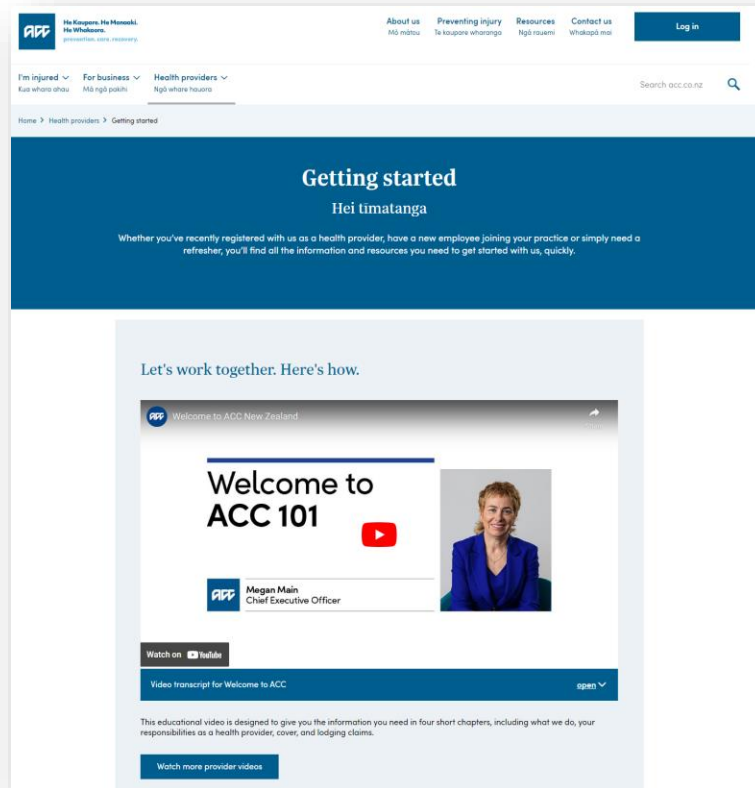

How to choose the right medical certification for your patient

Personal injury caused by accident? **No** Claim cannot be lodged with ACC

Was this person in paid employment at time of accident? **No** This person is not eligible for weekly compensation or vocational support. However, they are eligible for treatment and rehabilitation for their ACC-covered injury/ies.

Based on your assessment of this person, are they able to engage in any of their pre-injury job tasks? **No** Is this person functionally able to engage in any type of work or active rehabilitation?

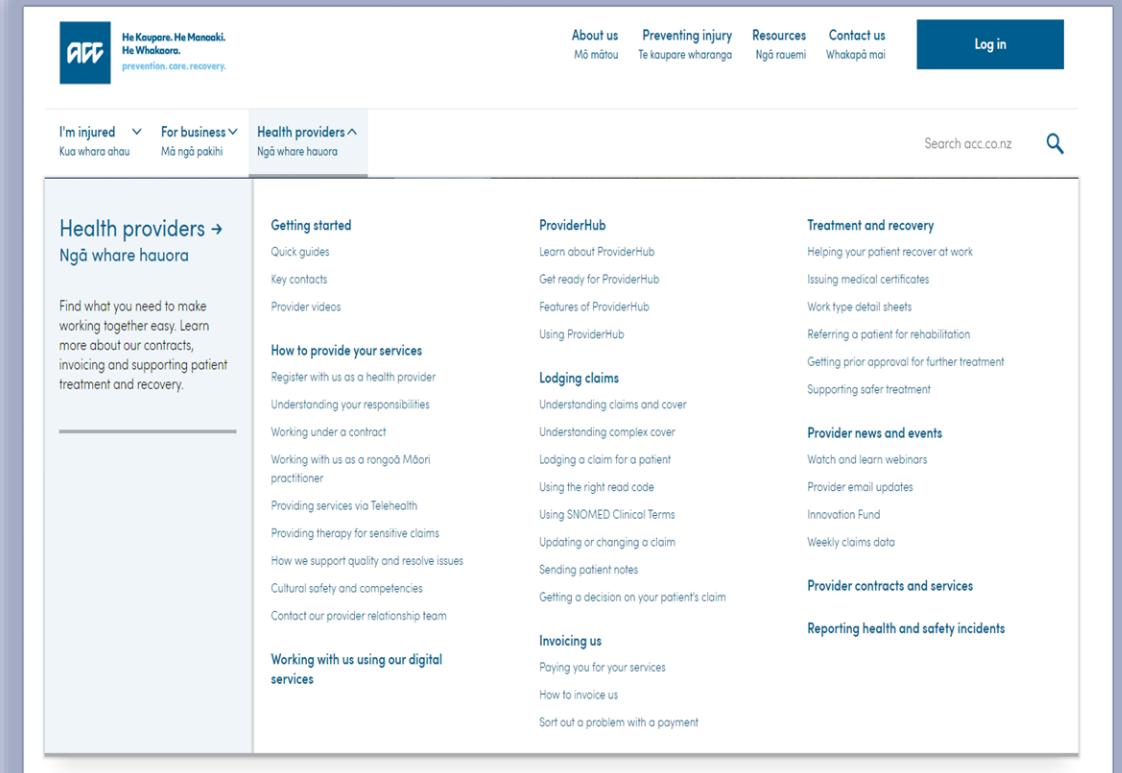
