

Motion #1 for PMAANZ Wellington branch AGM

We apply to the National Executive for an exemption to the Constitution – clause 34.2 (e). Instead of having to have four officers we have a single co-ordinator.

Rationale:

Branches operate differently to when the Constitution is written and it is no longer necessary to have a formal committee.

The co-ordinator would be the liaison with the National Executive and organise the local roster. Every two months one member would be responsible for organising a get together – this could be as simple as drinks at a pub, a tour of your practice, or an educational event if you have a topical speaker. At the most you are likely to be asked to organise one event every two or three years depending upon how many members we have.

We operated a similar model several years ago, albeit with a committee in place, and it meant that it wasn't onerous on anyone.

The idea would be to have the events in different parts of the region as we have several new members from the Hutt and Porirua as well as in Wellington.
